

## For You Project: Card



Laura used folded flowers to turn a simple card into a "wow!" card! She covered the card front with floral paper, then covered the bottom 3" with green striped paper. She sanded the edges of the whole card front and glued green ribbon overlapping the seams between the two papers. Laura cut four Flower Power shapes out of purple textured paper and sanded the edges. She attached a small gold pinwheel to the center of each folded flower with a white mini brad. She folded lengths of green ribbon in half and secured the loose ends behind the flowers, adding three ribbons to two of the flowers and one ribbon to the other flowers. Laura computer journaled "for you" onto parchment paper and glued it over a tag cut-out. She glued the tab over the ribbon length that runs across the card, then layered a flower with three ribbons on top and attached the flowers with one ribbon to each side. Laura covered the bottom portion of a 4"x5 1/2" piece of floral paper with green stripes paper, sanded the edges and glued it centered on the card inside. She glued a piece of parchment paper over the patterned papers and added the final folded flower to the bottom corner.
