

Hydrangea Favor Box Design By Sue Eldred for McGill, Inc.

Make the Hydrangea Favor Box and decorate your next party with something unique.



McGill Supplies Needed: 64520 - Paper Blossoms Mini Petals, 64502 - Paper Blossoms Birch Leaf, 65800 - Paper Blossoms Paper Tool Kit, and 65900 - Paper Blossoms Craft Molding Mat

1. Cover a 2-1/2" x 2-1/2" gift box with color coordinated scrapbook paper. Wrap 1" white ribbon around the box. Add a silver charm and tie knot.

Make the Hydrangea:

2. Punch the Mini-Petals punch 6-7 times. Select only the shapes with rounded petals, and cup each one with 5mm stylus.

3. Draw a small dot in center of each shape with a color coordinated marker.

4. Cut a 1" Styrofoam ball in half and paint it green.

5. Starting at the top of the painted ball, attach each of the formed flowers with a quick drying clear paper crafting glue.

6. Punch 4 Birch Leaves and shape with the 8mm stylus. Add veining details to the leaves with the 1mm stylus.

7. Glue leaves to the bottom of the Hydrangea flower. Then, add the finished Hydrangea flower to the top of the box to complete your project.
