## How to Make Bachelor's Buttons

### Supplies

#### Punches:

- Multi Daisy 64540 - 2 sets in Pansy, 1 set in Majestic Purple Dark
- Medium Daisy 64541 - 4 shapes in Wisteria, 1 shape in Ivy
- Punchline Diamond 52300

#### Tools:

- Paper Tool Kit and Case 65800
- Craft Molding Mat 65900

#### Additional:

- Cardstock: Wisteria, Pansy, Majestic Purple Dark, Ivy (Bazzill)
- Ink Blending Tool (Ranger)
- Ink: Purple (Tsukineko)
- Crafter's Pick Ultimate Adhesive
- Scrap Paper
- Craft Scissors
- Foam Dots



### Bachelor's Button Assembly:

1. Snip the ends of each Medium Daisy shape with the Punchline Diamond punch to create the irregular edge. Color the edges of the petals using the ink blending tool and the purple ink. Make 2 parallel cuts into each petal with a small craft scissors.
2. With the 8mm stylus on the Craft Molding Mat, follow step 1 to soften the paper of all the shapes by pushing and rolling the stylus over the shapes.
3. Add a foam dot to the center of 2 medium Daisy shapes. Mount second shape over the first, offsetting the petals. Glue one pair over the other, offsetting the petals.
4. Use the 6mm stylus on the Craft Molding Mat to soften and curve the other shapes. Push into the center of the smallest Daisy to cause it to curve up.
5. Glue together the 1" Daisy shapes offsetting the petals. Glue into the center of the Medium Daisy layers. Glue the smallest Daisy shape into the center. With fingers, push the petals together to form a tighter center.
6. Snip 2 petals out of the medium green Daisy shape. Use the 8mm Stylus on the Craft Molding Mat to soften and curve the paper. Glue the leaves to the side of the flower to complete the Bachelor Button.



### Steps to Prepare Paper Blossoms Shapes

Photo images for demonstration only. Shapes may not match this project. Steps needed vary per flower.

#### Step #1

Place a punched shape on the Craft Molding Mat. Press down with the 8mm Ball Stylus as you move it around in circular motions to soften the cardstock.



#### Step #2

Center the Tweezers over the narrow end of the shape. Use your fingers to squeeze the paper around the end of the tweezers.



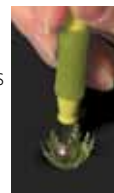
#### Step #3

Hold the narrow end of the shape and use the Tweezers to grab one side of the paper as you roll it back. Repeat on the other side of the shape.



#### Step #4

Place shape on the Craft Molding Mat. Use the 5mm stylus at a 90° angle to press down and roll in the center to curl up the sides.



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
