How to Make the Echinacea

Supplies

Punches:

- Multi Daisy 64540 - 8 suns - 4 in Marmalade Blast, 4 in Nourgat
- Large Daisy 64542 - 3 shapes in Berry Sensations
- Star Lily 64511 - 2 large shapes in Ivy

Tools:

- Paper Tool Kit and Case 65800
- Craft Molding Mat 65900



Additional:

- Cardstock: Berry Sensations, Marmalade Blast, Nougat, Ivy (Bazzill)
- Ink Blending Tool (Ranger)
- Ink: Vintage Photo (Ranger)
- Crafter's Pick Ultimate Adhesive
- Scrap Paper



Echinacea Assembly:

1. With the 8mm Stylus on the Craft Molding Mat, follow Step 1 to soften all the shapes by rolling the Stylus over the paper. Turn the 3 large Daisy shapes over and push into the center of the shape.
2. Squeeze each petal around the Tweezers to roll inward.
3. Glue Daisy layers one over the other, offsetting the petals.
4. On the Craft Molding Mat, use the 6mm Stylus to push into the center of each Sun shape to cause it to curve up as shown in Step 4. Use Tweezers to tighten the shape to make the flower center.
5. Start with the Marmalade Blast and glue a Nougat Sun into it. Alternate the other colors to complete the center. Glue over the large Daisy layer.
6. Rub Vintage photo ink along the edges of the 2 Lily shapes with the Ink Blending Tool. Use the 8mm Stylus on the Craft Molding Mat to soften the 2 Lily shapes. With Tweezers, grab each shape along the center and squeeze paper around the Tweezers. (Step 3)
7. With 1mm Stylus on a hard surface, draw veining details on each leaf. Glue each leaf around the flower to complete the Echinacea.



Steps to Prepare Paper Blossoms Shapes

Photo images for demonstration only. Shapes may not match this project. Steps needed vary per flower.

Step #1

Place a punched shape on the Craft Molding Mat. Press down with the 8mm Ball Stylus as you move it around in circular motions to soften the cardstock.



Step #2

Center the Tweezers over the narrow end of the shape. Use your fingers to squeeze the paper around the end of the tweezers.



Step #3

Hold the narrow end of the shape and use the Tweezers to grab one side of the paper as you roll it back. Repeat on the other side of the shape.



Step #4

Place shape on the Craft Molding Mat. Use the 5mm stylus at a 90° angle to press down and roll in the center to curl up the sides.



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
