How To Make a Marigold

Marigold Supplies

Punches:

- Multi Daisy 64540 - 4 -1" Daisy, 3 small Daisy, 2 Suns
- Medium Daisy 64541 - 2 shapes
- Multi Pear Petals - 16 shapes smallest Pear
- Fern 92084 - 3 shapes

Tools:

- Paper Tool Kit and Case 65800
- Craft Molding Mat 65900

Additional:

- Cardstock: Yellow-orange, Palo Verde (Bazzill)
- Orange Brush Marker
- Crafter's Pick Ultimate Adhesive
- Non-stick Craft Mat or Scrap Paper



Marigold Assembly

1. Punch out 16 of the smallest pear shapes from, two 1 1/2" Daisies, four 1" Daisies, three 5/8" Daisies and 3 suns from yellow/orange card stock. Punch out 3 Fern shapes from dark green cardstock.
2. Use the orange brush marker to color each petal by sweeping out from the end to the tip.
3. Place all the shapes on the Craft Molding Mat. Follow Step #1 to soften the paper on 16 small Pear shapes, 2 Medium Daisy shapes, 4 small Daisy, 3 smallest Daisy, 3 Sun shapes and 2-3 Fern shapes using the 8mm ball Stylus.
4. Turn all the Pear shapes over and with the 5mm Stylus, rub with pressure across the bottom of the Pear shapes to cause a curve along the edge.
5. Turn all the Daisy shapes over and using the 5mm Stylus, push into the center of each shape. Next, rub the 5mm Stylus across the top of each Daisy petal to create a curve along the edge.
6. Slightly flatten a 1" Daisy shape to use as the flower base. Place a spot of glue on scrap paper or non-stick craft sheet. Dip the first Pear shape into glue and place into the center of the Daisy base. Dip the second Pear shape into glue and place in the opposing position in the center of the base. Add the other Pear shapes to create a layer around the base. Repeat with the second 1" Daisy shape. Glue one layer over the other using a foam dot.
7. Glue the 2 Medium Daisies to each other offsetting the petals slightly. Attach to the Pear petal layer with a foam dot. Repeat the procedure with three 1" Daisy shapes and two Sun shapes. Attach the Daisy layer to the Medium Daisies using a foam dot. Attach the Sun layer over the 1" Daisy layer with a foam dot.
8. Follow Step #4 to create a deep curve in the smallest Daisy shapes. Pinch the base of the shapes to gather the petals in tight groups. Glue the 3 Daisies over each other offsetting the petals slightly. Glue to the top of the flower layers.
9. Slightly flatten the Fern shapes and attach around the flower to complete the Marigold.




Steps to Prepare Paper Blossoms Shapes

Photo images for demonstration only. Shapes may not match this project. Steps needed vary per flower.

Step #1

Place a punched shape on the Craft Molding Mat. Press down with the 8mm Ball Stylus as you move it around in circular motions to soften the cardstock.



Step #2

Center the Tweezers over the narrow end of the shape. Use your fingers to squeeze the paper around the end of the tweezers.



Step #3

Hold the narrow end of the shape and use the Tweezers to grab one side of the paper as you roll it back. Repeat on the other side of the shape.



Step #4

Place shape on the Craft Molding Mat. Use the 5mm stylus at a 90° angle to press down and roll in the center to curl up the sides.



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
