How To Make Mini Roses

Mini Rose Supplies



1. **Punch** - Petite Petals 64007
Tools - Paper Tool Kit & Case 65800
- Craft Molding Mat 65900
Cardstock: Pinkini, Lily Pond (Bazzill)
Adhesive: Hot Glue Gun



2. Punch 4 flowers of the rounded petal shape in Bazzill Pinkini and one "star" shape for the leaf in Bazzill Lily Pond.



3. Place shapes on the Craft Molding Mat. Use the 8mm stylus to press down, using a circular motion. This softens the card stock and causes the shape to curl.



4. Do this for all 4 petals.



5. Take a flower shape and gently push the petals together to form the bud. Put a small amount of glue on the petals to keep them together.



6. Be careful as the hot glue can burn your fingers.



7. Take the next flower and spread a thin layer of hot glue in the center.



8. Center the bud and push the petals up.



9. Do the same for the next two flower shapes.



10. Be sure to alternate how the petals line up as you place them in the next flower.



11. This will create a more realistic looking flower. For a fuller Mini Rose, add another flower layer.



12. Spread a thin layer of hot glue in the center of the green star shape. Center the rose bud on it.



13. Using the tweezers, curl the petals from the two bottom layers down.



14. Completed Mini Roses can be enhanced further with added textures by sponging, airbrushing, or adding glitter.
