

## Rose Gift Box Design By Sue Eldred for McGill, Inc.



**Punches needed:** Pear, Alpine Snowflake, Birch Leaf, Floral Petals, and Garden Petals

**Other items needed:** 6" or 8" round diameter gift box, Red, pink, rose, green card stock, Tea Rose Ink pad and glue.

### **Make the Garden Roses:**

1. Punch 12 Pear shapes and 10 Garden petals for each Rose.
  2. Place shapes on the Craft Molding Mat. Using the 8mm stylus, press down into the center of the shape as you move the tool in a circular motion over the entire paper shape. Paper will curl up around the stylus.
  3. Place the tweezers at the smaller, defined end of the shape. With index finger and thumb, pinch the paper around end of the tweezers.
  4. Holding the pinched end between finger and thumb, use the tweezers to grasp each side of the shape and roll back to form petal.
  5. Punch 1 Snowflake out of green cardstock and place on the Craft Molding Mat. Hold the 8mm stylus at a 90 degree angle. Press down as you roll the stylus in circular motion over the shape to form a cup. Petals and leaves attach to this flower base.
  6. Dip the narrow end of the first 6 large Pear petals in glue and attach them to the cupped Snowflake arms. Add a second layer of 6 large Pear petals, offsetting them in between the first layer of petals.
- Caution: Don't use glue on or over the Craft Molding Mat. It needs to stay clean and dry.**
7. Next, glue the small Pear petal shapes in layers, staggering them over the larger ones working from the outside in towards the center.
  8. To make the center of the Rose, use the tweezers to tightly roll the last 2 small Pear shape petals and link them one into the other. Glue into the center.
  9. Punch 2 Birch Leaf shapes from the green cardstock. Follow step #2 above to prepare the shape. Use the 1mm stylus to add thin veining details to each leaf.
  10. Glue a leaf to each side of the flower to complete the Garden Rose.

### **Make the Floral Rose:**

1. Punch Floral Petals 6 times with Cream Cardstock for each Rose.
2. Rub the edge of each shape with Tea Rose Dye Ink to add color details.
3. Place the shapes on the Craft Molding Mat. Using the 8mm stylus, press down into the center of the shape as you move the tool in a circular motion over the entire paper shape. Paper will curl up around the stylus.
4. Place the tweezers at the smaller, defined end of the shape. With index finger and thumb, pinch the paper around the end of the tweezers.
5. Holding the pinched end between finger and thumb, use the tweezers to grasp each side of the shape and roll back

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to form petal.

6. Punch a Snowflake out of green cardstock and place on the Craft Molding Mat. Hold the 8mm stylus at a 90 degree angle to the paper. Press down and roll the stylus around in the center to form a cup. Petals and leaves attach to this flower base.

7. Dip the narrow end of the first 6 large petals into glue and adhere to the cupped Snowflake arms. Continue with the next largest petals to the smallest offsetting them in between layers until you get to the center. The last 2-3 small petals curl inward to create the center.

***Caution: Don't use glue on or over the Craft Molding Mat. It needs to stay clean and dry.***

8. Punch 2 Birch Leaf shapes from the green cardstock. Follow step #3 above to prepare the shape. Use the 1mm stylus to add thin veining details to each leaf.

9. Glue a leaf to each side of the flower to complete the Floral Rose.

10. Depending on the size of the box, make variety of Roses and arrange over the top.
