**Doreen's Journal**

Burgundy and pink for the filigree heart, along with the organza ribbon for



the front bow, embellish this gift box quite nicely.



**Heidi's Heart Card:**

Ingredients: January Kit, pink scrapbook paper, green washi paper, crystals, seed beads, Valentine text sticker

Tools: Large sakura punch, small lotus punch, tiny sun punch, tiny flower punch, large and small birch punches, embossing stylus and foam board.



**Victorian Happy Day Card**

I layered paper from the kit, scrapbook paper, a doily and pearls to give this card a Victorian look. I added punched roses, buds, and fringed flowers using the pink paper included in the kit. I then added punched leaves and ferns. The pretty heart shaped rhinestones added the finishing touch.

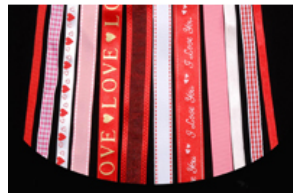

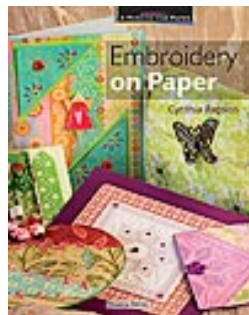
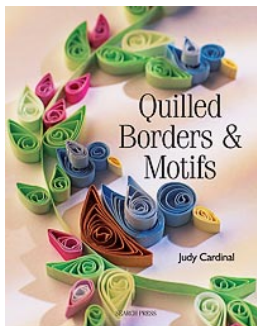

**Gift Box**

Ingredients:  
January Kit, brown velvet paper, brown quilling strips

Tools: Hole punch, large and small birch punches, fold-it swirls template, quilling tool, embossing stylus, air erase pen



**Velvet Card**

Ingredients: January Kit, wine and brown velvet papers, pink crystals, pink scrapbook paper

Tools: Quilling tool, heart punch



**Heart Aperture Card:**

This is a simple design made by first inserting the red paper behind the cut-out heart area. Punched flowers are lightly shaped and then embellished with pearls in the centers. The heart rhinestones finish it off for a quick design.

**Love Tag**

I made this from the note card in the kit by cutting along the fold. Then I used an accessory sheet for the dark pink background and a lighter shade of pink for the quilling.



**Chocolate Box**

This box is the perfect shade of pale pink and chocolate brown. The solid pink top is perfect for embellishing with your favorite quill work. For my project I used the burgundy quilling paper to husk a flower, added a fringed center, and husked green leaves. The heart-shaped rhinestone and pearls dress up this project a bit for the perfect gift for that special Valentine.



**Trina's Card**

For this project I used the card with the heart cut-out (perfect for Valentine's Day). First I cut the pink paper to fit behind the heart and also used the same paper to cut strips for the folded roses. I added punched ferns and half pearls. For extra dimension I attached the pink organza ribbon. I left the middle of the card blank so I could use it for Birthday, Valentine's Day, Mother's Day, or a Wedding by simply adding the sentiment in the middle of the heart!

*Free Pattern ~ Fringed Flowers* written by DT Ann Martin (reprint from June 2005)

To make unusual fringed flowers, here is a technique to try:

**Polly's Scatter Mum**

A unique look I learned from Polly Wiggins of Kansas, the fringe is cut from a wedge-shaped strip of paper. The wedge shape is what creates the scattered-length effect of the petals. Cut a strip 4" in length that is 3/8" wide at the short end and angles gradually up to 1" in width at the far end, leaving the bottom edge straight. Fringe finely by hand, cutting toward the straight edge. Roll the fringed strip tightly from the narrow end. Glue closed and fluff out fringe, curling it downward with your needle tool. If you would like your flower to have a center, glue a 4" tight coil to the narrow end before rolling the fringe.

When using quilling strips from a bag, make sure the cut ends are facing the opening of the bag. To remove strips without tangling, take the required strips from the inside loop. This will leave the remaining strips intact.
